Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of the Infrastructure Services work completed during the months of July and August.

Aerodrome Operations

- Bi-annual inspections on pumps and tanks were performed with recommendations of servicing and replacement of equipment.
- Increase in landing both private and chartered.
- Routine grounds and runway maintenance performed.

Cemetery Operations

- The Weed Man, a lawn maintenance contractor from the Sault Ste Marie performed routine spraying to enhance lawn growth and to deter insects related infestation of the grounds.
- Placement and levelling of headstones has been constant throughout the season.

Landfill Operations

- With the schedule of Tuesday, Friday and Saturday from 9:30am to 3:30pm the landfill has been steady with customers and contractors.
- The bin system seems to be working well only allowing large trailers or contractor bins to be dumped in the active cell.
- Kresin Engineering was contacted to stake the second cell so that staff can
 prepare a small portion in case the active cell fills faster than anticipated
 making a smooth transition without interruption.

Road Operations

- Calcium was placed on gravel roads
- Brushing of gravel roadways were started including Catfish, Steep Hill and sections of the Mission.
- The old Magpie Restaurant was demolished for property standards and safety reasons.
- Line painting was completed on roadways and parking areas.

Water and Sewer Operations

- Routine maintenance and sampling performed weekly.
- Flushing of hydrants throughout townsite and Mission village.
- Upgrading and replacing electrical components at the Water Treatment plant.

Capital Projects

- Intake Project A 30-day review period of the Environment Assessment (EA) summary report was required by the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA). The review period ends September 15, 2024.
- Cemetery J Provost Contracting Ltd started on the Phase 1 portion of the landfill expansion with a completion date of November due to the wait time of the new columbariums and benches.
- Airport Funding the new sand dome was completed and a revised RFT
 was issued for the Accessible Washroom renovation with a tentative
 contractor being awarded in September.

Month Ahead

Forecasted for September:

- Sidewalk rehabilitation
- Continue brushing of roads
- Continue working at landfill expansion
- Cleaning of ditches and culverts
