#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of the Infrastructure Services work completed during the month of June.

#### **Aerodrome Operations**

- The Loomex Group performed a week-long training with staff. Employees were trained on regulations, fuelling, fuel sampling and airside best practices.
- Propairs' plane schedule has increased with an extra plane on Wednesdays and Friday.

#### **Cemetery Operations**

- Summer students are grass cutting all 4 cemeteries on a 2-week rotation.
- Routine maintenance on grounds and headstones are being done when weather permits.

#### **Landfill Operations**

- Daily pushing / packing and cover continues on the active cell.
- Day Construction has removed 400 used tires from the site with another pick up scheduled in July.

#### **Road Operations**

- Gravel roads are being graded for upcoming calcium in July.
- Parking lines, stop blocks and cross walks have started to be painted.
- Brushing around hydrants, street signs and intersections where visibility to traffic is a hazard is being performed.

### Water and Sewer Operations

- Routine maintenance and sampling performed weekly.
- Upgrades were done on Mission Tower which included new safety equipment, replace broken mixer, clean the interior chamber and touch up painting where required.

### Capital Projects

- Intake Project – Kresin Engineering Corp. with Rebecca Weatherall hosted an Open House.
- Cemetery – 2 bids were received for the expansion. The bids were over budget so staff went back to the engineer with recommendations to lower costs. The revised tender will then be brought to the lowest bid for pricing.
- Airport Funding – Mike Moore Construction started on the foundation for the new sand shed with a completion in July. The accessible washroom RFT was overbudget so will need to be revised and put back out for tender in July.

### Month Ahead

Forecasted for July:

- Summer students to continue grass cutting.
- Continue all aspects of line painting.
- Start on sidewalk rehabilitation
- Continue working at landfill expansion.
- Demolish old Magpie restaurant
- Continue with roadway brushing and ditching
