**REMINDER**



The Municipality has restrictions on curb side garbage pickup. The limit of waste per week, per household pickup is 6 receptacles not exceeding 12 cubic feet i.e. 6 regular sized garbage bags.

The contents must be bagged and only household waste i.e. food scraps, paper, plastic, cans, etc.

Hazardous Waste is collected annually at the Infrastructure Services department on Hazardous Waste Day – Advertisement will come for this event, the event is held each year in the fall.

The Municipal Landfill operates Tues – Fri 11 a.m. – 3 p.m. & Saturday 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. for all other items to be deposited, excluding hazardous waste.

**Please note:**

The landfill accepts yard waste i.e. grass clippings, bush trimmings, leaves, tree trimmings - in biodegradable bags free of charge.

Wawa Metal Recycling will accept clean Tin & Aluminum can, located off Trembley.

Scrap Metal contractors will pick up metal and certain appliances at the end of your driveway if notified; conditions on what is accepted should be discussed with the contractor.
