### **NORTH ALGOMA'S COVID-19 ASSESSMENT CENTRE IS MOVING!**

The Lady Dunn Health Centre and the Municipality of Wawa collaborated to launch the COVID-19 Assessment Centre on April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the Michipicoten Memorial Community Centre (MMCC).

With the province in stage 3 of its reopening plan the Assessment Centre will operate out of the MMCC up until September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 as the community centre prepares to reopen. The Assessment Centre will then move on to the Lady Dunn Health Centre site (receiving entrance) as of September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Details about how to access the new site will be forthcoming.

We would like to express our deepest gratitude to the Municipality of Wawa for enabling access to COVID-19 testing closer to home for more than 1400 North Algoma residents and workers since opening.
